

M5 J1-2 Oldbury Viaduct works e-bulletin – 11 May 2018

We are still aiming to complete the works on the southbound carriageway by the end of June this year, subject to weather conditions as laying waterproofing material and new surfacing requires dry conditions. We will then divert traffic onto the southbound carriageway and begin work on the northbound.

The concrete repairs to the southbound carriageway are now around 95% complete, we are currently; completing repairs to the 'special structures' areas, installing kerbs and waterproofing material prior to resurfacing.

The first sections of new verge have been completed. The verges contain; drainage units to take surface water away from the carriageway down to the pipework underneath the deck and ducting to carry the overhead gantry and new lighting column cabling.



Road closures

- concrete repairs
- traffic management equipment maintenance
- carriageway inspection and repairs
- installation of new electrical equipment
