Full terms and conditions for the photography competition:

1. All submissions must be your own photographs, they must be good quality and include the location and a caption that starts with '#MalvernEnviroWeek2018 photo comp'. You can tag Malvern Hills District Council as many times as you like but if you are emailing your images, entries are limited to five per person and should be sent as jpegs.
2. Submissions must allow for Visit the Malverns and Malvern Hills District Council to share photographs freely, including, but not limited to: social media, websites, email newsletters and promotional material.
3. By submitting your photograph/s you are confirming that you have the permission of any individuals featured in the photograph, or that of their parent/guardian if under 16 years of age, for their image to be used by Malvern Hills District Council in our media (as listed in above in point 2).
4. If you are under 16 years of age, please ask a parent or guardian to make the submission on your behalf, but state that it is your work in their caption or email.
5. Entrants must not be professional photographers.
6. Images must not be digitally enhanced or manipulated.
7. The welfare of wildlife is of greater importance than the photograph itself. Please take care to avoid damage to the environment in the process of your photography.
8. If emailing your images, please note that Malvern Hills District Council will not pass your personal details on to any third party; however your details may be retained in accordance with Data Protection law.
