Worcestershire libraries provide opportunities for people to stay connected with others through the following free library services:

Library Service at Home

If you have difficulty accessing the library due to age, disability or long term illness, the Library Service at Home can help. Dedicated library staff and volunteers pick books based on your preferences and deliver them to your door.

Connect Bubbles

Be part of a safe, online library community, led by library staff and volunteers. Connect with others over a shared interest or activity. Connect Bubbles are small group chat sessions which take place online using Zoom.

One-to-One calls

Reading Friends One-to-One calls are designed for people who are unable to access online group sessions. Friendly volunteers will provide regular contact by telephone to read, talk and share stories.
