Fantastic news as more areas scheduled to go live in Worcestershire

Roll-out is going superfast and many more locations will be going live shortly, including more homes and businesses served by Badsey, Bromsgrove, Druid's Heath, Great Witley, Hagley, Hallow, Hartlebury, Hillside, Knightwick, Romsley and Wythall telephone exchanges.

There will also be some communities getting their first fibre deployment during the coming weeks and months, cabinets going live in these locations will benefit some premises served by the Birtsmorton, Colwall, Eardiston, Newnham Bridge and Severn Stoke telephone exchanges.

Check out the cabinet status page on our website to see estimated go live dates for over a hundred cabinets. This list is updated as and when locations go live, or if they are moved in the rollout plan. Many more communities will have fibre roll-out underway in 2016/17. We're rolling-out fibre faster than it takes to lose that summer tan, so please help us spread the word and encourage friends and family in Worcestershire to register via our website: www.superfastworcestershire.com.



90% of Wyre Forest Businesses able to get fibre Broadband

A significant milestone was hit recently when it was announced that over 90% of businesses in Wyre Forest can now access fibre broadband, from a starting point of just 44% when the programme commenced. When the ambitious programme to roll out high-speed fibre broadband across the county was announced just over two years ago, Superfast Worcestershire set a target of reaching 90% of the county's businesses in support of the County Council's 'Open for Business' initiative. Mark Garnier MP's visit to Witley Jones, Stourport-based education furniture specialists, coincided with news from lead partners Worcestershire County Council and BT that more than 85% of county businesses overall are now able to access faster fibre broadband as a result of the partnership, with 90% availability in Wyre Forest.

Simon Downes, sales director of Witley Jones said: "We run a busy office with 12 people who may all be online at the same time using the internet for sourcing and researching supplies and designs. Each project is individual which means we are working with architects and designers sharing large design files and plans on a daily basis. Upload speeds are particularly important when we have huge design files to share. Since upgrading to superfast fibre we have seen our upload and download speeds increase more than 10 times and everyone can be online at the same time with no delays making us more efficient and effective. On our shop floor we use specialist software to drive the machinery. The suppliers of our computercontrolled wood machinery are based in Italy and they can now remotely diagnose and fix faults reducing any delays in production."


