Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is herein after referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order: -

- That Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Great Witley) (Restricted Roads and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2000 is hereby revoked in its entirety
- No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- All other Orders made prior to the date of this Order applying to any of the lengths of roads specified in the Order are hereby revoked or varied as may be required.
- 6. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council, (Various Roads, Great Witley) (Restricted Roads and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2000 (Revocation) and (Various Roads, Great Witley) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on 28 January 2021.



- The County of Hereford and Worcester (50 mph Speed Limit) (No 3) Order 1982 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
- The County of Hereford and Worcester (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 11)
 Order 1982 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
- The lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act of 1984;
- No person shall drive or cause or permit be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along those length of roads specified in Schedule 2 of this Order;
- This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Great Witley) (Restricted Roads and 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2000 and shall come into operation on 7 August 2000.
